Administrative History

The Biological Discussion Club at the University of British Columbia began in the early 1920s. Its goal was to stimulate interest in biological subjects at the University through the reading of papers of general interest and by other means as determined by the Club. In 1949 the name of the club was changed to the Biology Club. The Club finally ceased operation in 1965.

Scope and Content

The fonds consists of Club minutes (1925-1965) and membership lists (1962-1964).
