## **Biographical Sketch**

Roy Bishop Stokes (1915-1995) received his M.A. and M. Phil. from Nottingham University. After heading the School of Librarianship at Loughborough Technical College, he came to the University of British Columbia in 1970 where he succeeded Sam Rothstein as director of the Library School. He continued in this position until his retirement in 1982. Throughout his career, Stokes was interested in bibliography and he published a number of books on the subject.

## **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of autographs collected by Roy Stokes, book descriptions he created, various miscellaneous materials found in books, correspondence pertaining to a proposed bibliographical tour by graduate Library School students to the United Kingdom, and bibliographic descriptions of books in the Colbeck Collection by both he and Library Science students.
