## Fonds description

Simpson Family fonds. – 1906-2009, predominant 1920-1979.

## Biographical sketches

Stanley Merriam Simpson (b.10 August 1886, d. 20 March 1959), also referred to as Stanley M. Simpson, or S. M. Simpson, and was born in Chatsworth, ON. He arrived in Kelowna in 1913 at the age of 27. Here, he plied a carpentry trade and eventually established a screen door manufacturing company (S. M. Simpson Sash & Door, later S. M. Simpson Ltd., established 1916). Throughout his career, he established a box factory, a veneer plant, and a sawmill, all centered in the Kelowna, BC area. He also owned mill operations in Peachland, Lumby, and Malakwa, and operated a tree farm on the west side of Okanagan Lake.

In 1916, he married Bertha Birch, (b. 1885, d. 17 April 1917). A son, Horace Birch Simpson (b. 17 March 1917, d. 20 September 1994) was born.

On 25 November, 1944, following a series destructive mill fires, S. M. Simpson was approached by the city of Kelowna and asked to give the City of Kelowna an option to purchase the parcel of land damaged in the fire on Kelowna's waterfront on Okanagan Lake. S. M. Simpson agreed, but only under particular terms of sale governing the exclusive civic or community use of the land, and conditions of resale, which precluded any subsequent commercial uses of the land. A total of nearly eight acres was purchased by the City for \$55,000. The City acknowledged that the purchase price was considerably less than it would have been if it were purchased for the purpose of subdivision and commercial use. This agreement would come to be known as "The Simpson Covenant" and/or "The Simpson Covenants," and/or "The Kelowna Sawmill Covenants."

Horace Birch Simpson (b. 17 March 1917, d. 20 September 1994), also referred to as Horace Simpson, Horace B. Simpson, or H. B. Simpson, was the eldest son of S. M. Simpson. He married Joan Katherine Jennens on 17 November, 1937. A daughter, Sharron J. Simpson, was born.

From a young age, H. B. frequently spent time at his father's mill. After graduation he joined the mill as part of its workforce. In the 1940s, he became assistant general manager, and later, general manager. He transitioned to president at the time that his father was incapacitated by stroke, in 1955.

H. B. was instrumental in the launch of the new S. M. Simpson Ltd. Plywood plant in 1957 and made the decision to sell S. M. Simpson Ltd. and its subsidiaries to Crown Zellerbach in 1965. He stayed on as general manager for one year. He died in September of 1994.

Sharron J. Simpson was born and grew up in Kelowna. After attending university, Sharron Simpson resided in Vancouver, Montreal, and Toronto before returning to Kelowna in 1984. Her occupations have included social worker, stockbroker, politician, and teacher.

Sharron J. Simpson has been actively engaged in advocacy for the preservation of family and community heritage and led the successful 2007 court challenge of the City of Kelowna's proposed dissolution of the Simpson Covenant which was put in place by her grandfather, Stanley Merriam Simpson.



#### **Custodial history**

Custody of materials transferred from S. M. Simpson Ltd. offices and succeeding businesses to Sharron J. Simpson, who donated these aggregations as well as her own materials to UBC Okanagan Library in 2014.

#### Scope and content

The fonds consists of two separate streams of documentation. The first consists of documents, photographs, and artifacts pertaining to the operations of a succession of sawmills and wood manufacturing plants founded by Stanley Merriam Simpson and assumed by his son, Horace B. Simpson in the Okanagan area.

The second stream consists of the materials generated by Sharron J. Simpson. Sharron J. Simpson's records within this aggregation are primarily in relation to legal proceedings against the City of Kelowna in pursuit of the maintenance of the Simpson Covenant. In the 2000s, the City sought to dissolve the Covenant; Sharron J. Simpson founded the Save the Heritage Simpson Covenant Society to challenge this initiative.

In total fonds consists of approximately 2,600 photographs in various forms, including some duplicates. Textual records provide documentation of legal proceedings, finances, operations, safety initiatives, administration, civic engagement, publicity, and labour relations relating to mill business, general family research, and writing samples. Artifacts include exemplars of production and souvenir materials.

## Sous-fonds descriptions

S. M. Simpson Ltd. sous-fonds. – ca. 1904-1994, predominant 1924-1965. 2m of textual records ca. 1,070 photographs 30 artifacts

#### Administrative history

- S. M. Simpson Ltd. incorporated in 1924. Prior to this S. M. Simpson operated a series of sole proprietorships between 1913 and 1924. Some businesses, including a sash and door factory on Abbott Street (established 1916) operated in downtown Kelowna and were subsumed by S. M. Simpson Ltd. The sash and door factory operated until 1948. Other businesses, such as his portable sawmills held variously independently or in partnerships, were located in areas including Winfield and Ellison.
- S. M. Simpson Ltd. purchased land at Manhattan Beach along the lakeshore in Kelowna's north end in 1930, where he began constructing a sawmill. In 1933, a box factory and a veneer plant were added to the site.
- S. M. Simpson Ltd. purchased The Kelowna Sawmill in 1942, but the company was first established in 1892 by Bernard Lequime, who subsequently sold it to David Lloyd-Jones in 1901. S. M. Simpson operated it until it was destroyed by fire in 1944. The corporate Kelowna Sawmill Co. Ltd. was maintained and became the retail arm of S. M. Simpson Ltd. until 1956, when retail operations ceased.

The Province of British Columbia created Forest Management licenses in 1951, and S. M. Simpson Ltd. was awarded Tree Farm Licence #9. Following this, S. M. Simpson Ltd. created S&K Ltd. to add a plywood manufacturing facility to the Manhattan site. It began operations in 1957.

In the following years S. M. Simpson Ltd. purchased other sawmills and logging operations, including Trautman Garraway in Peachland (1955), Peachland Sawmill & Box (1955), McLean Sawmills (1957), Lumby Timber Co (1959), Ferguson Brothers Lumber (1962), Stave Lumber (1962) Eagle Pass Lumber (1963), R&L Lumber (1964).

In 1965, H. B. Simpson sold S. M. Simpson Ltd. and its several associates and subsidiaries to the Canadian instance of Crown Zellerbach Corporation: Crown Zellerbach Canada. It continued operating as the S. M. Simpson Division of Crown Zellerbach Canada for several years until the name was changed to simply Crown Zellerbach Canada. In 1969, Crown Zellerbach purchased several more sawmills in the region, including Armstrong Sawmills operations in Armstrong, Enderby, Vernon and Falkland, as well as Ponderosa Pine Lumber Co. in 1970.

In 1981 Crown Zellerbach Canada was purchased by Fletcher Challenge Canada Ltd. The entity's name was changed to Crown Forest, and in 1987 the name changed again to Fletcher Challenge Canada Ltd. The company was then subsequently purchased by Riverside Forest Products in 1992. In 2004 Riverside Forest Products was purchased by Tolko Industries Ltd. which operated until 2020.

#### Scope and content

The S. M. Simpson Ltd. sous-fonds consists predominantly of the records of the corporation of S. M. Simpson Ltd., which included operational subdivisions such as the Kelowna Sawmill Co. Ltd. (retail), S&K



Ltd. (plywood), Tree Farm Licence #9, and others. It also includes records generated by Stanley Merriam Simpson before the corporate life of S. M. Simpson Ltd. The sous-fonds also includes materials dating to after the sale of S. M. Simpson Ltd. 1965.

The sous-fonds consists of a photographic record that documents the wood processing entity established by S. M. Simpson across iterations of corporate ownership, as well as business records relating to substantial operations, labour relations, safety programs, legal proceedings, and administration.

#### Scope and content

Series consists of documentary record generated by the business activities of Crown Zellerbach Canada Ltd, also doing business as Southern Interior Wood Products. Series also includes older materials from mills acquired at the same time as S. M. Simpson Ltd., but which may not have been affiliated with S. M. Simpson Ltd.

For several years after the acquisition of S. M. Simpson Ltd., those holdings taken over from S. M. Simpson Ltd. were referred to the S. M. Simpson Ltd. Division of Crown Zellerbach Canada.

In 1973, the name was changed to Crown Zellerbach Canada, and the corporation embarked on a modernization program, documented in this series. In 1981, it was purchased by Fletcher Challenge Canada Ltd. and the company name was changed to Crown Forest.

Series contains documentation of sawmills located in Kelowna, Lumby, Enderby, Armstrong, Falkland, and Monte Lake, British Columbia.

Scope and content

Series documents Sharron J. Simpson's activism as the leader of a legal initiative challenging the proposed dissolution of the Simpson Covenant, a restrictive land sale agreement made between her grandfather, Stanley M. Simpson and the City of Kelowna in 1946.

To explain the context of the creation of the covenant: following a mill fire on S. M. Simpson Ltd. land on what is now Kelowna's downtown waterfront (around the area known as Manhattan Point) S. M. Simpson sold this land to the City of Kelowna with the understanding that S. M. would sell at a reduced rate, and the City of Kelowna would agree that the land be used for civic or community (not commercial) purposes. In the 2000s, the City of Kelowna moved to dissolve the so-called "Simpson Covenant," and in response Sharron J. Simpson launched a court challenge to enforce the maintenance of the covenant.

Series contains correspondence, legal documents (including petitions, reasons for judgment, affidavits, civic records and land title office records, City of Kelowna memoranda, press clippings and press releases, appraisal records, etc.).

The second stream consists of the materials generated by Sharron J. Simpson. Sharron J. Simpson's records within this aggregation are primarily in relation to legal proceedings against the City of Kelowna in pursuit of the maintenance of the Simpson Covenant. In the 2000s, the City sought to dissolve the Covenant; Sharron J. Simpson founded the Save the Heritage

Simpson Covenant Society to challenge this initiative.

In total fonds consists of approximately 2,600 photographs in various forms, including some duplicates. Textual record provides documentation of legal proceedings, finances, operations, safety initiatives, administration, civic engagement, publicity, and labour relations relating to mill business, general family research, and writing samples. Artifacts include exemplars of

production and souvenir materials.
