

RECOGNISANCE OF BAIL.

COLONY OF VANCOUVER ISLAND }

BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the *Eight* day of *February*
in the *Twentieth* year of the reign of Queen Victoria, *Harry Wilmer,*
Mh Choo, Eli Marks, Sophy Colomb,
and George Welch
cometh before me, *Augustus Heuberton Esq*, one of Her Majesty's
Justices of the Peace for the said Colony, and severally acknowledged themselves to owe to our said
Lady the Queen, that is to say the said *Harry Wilmer, Mh Choo*
Eli Marks, Sophy Colomb, and George
Welch in the sum of *Five hundred*
dollars each each,

to be respectively levied of their lands and tenements, goods and chattels, if the said *Harry Wilmer*
Mh Choo, Eli Marks, Sophy Colomb, and
George Welch shall make default in the performance of the condition underwritten hereon.

The condition of this Recognisance is such that if the above bounden *Harry Wilmer*

peace within the said *Colony* ~~District~~, and likewise to hear and determine divers felonies, trespasses, and other
misdemeanors in the said *Colony* ~~District~~ committed,) at the next *Assizes* ~~Sessions~~ of the
Peace to be holden in and for the said *Colony* ~~District~~, then and there to *give evidence and prosecute* ~~answer to our Sovereign Lady the~~
~~Queen~~, for and concerning the *Charge of Robbery*
with suspicion whereof the said *Mh Choo*
stands charged before *Augustus Heuberton Esq* the said
Justice, and to do and receive what shall by the Court be then and there enjoined him, and shall not
depart the Court without license; then the above written Recognisance shall be void.
