We have just received a copy of the above mentioned letter in which we note that the counsel for the University has confirmed October 6, 7, and 11 for the Harriet van Santen arbitration. These dates were confirmed without our agreement.

At the September 15th Labour/Grievance Committee meeting the Union and the University agreed that:

- 1) The above dates were unacceptable to the University.
- 2) The Union requested four consecutive days.
- 3) Both parties indicated a preference for dates in November.

This letter is directed to your attention since it was our understanding that you would undertake the responsibility of arranging mutually acceptable dates.

and A.U.C.E. - Harriet Van Santen


This will confirm our telephone conversation of September 14, 1977, that the above captioned parties have agreed upon you as the sole arbitrator to deal with an arbitration respecting a university employee Harriet Van Santen.

This will also confirm that we have agreed that we will reserve the 6th, 7th and 11th of October for the arbitration subject to my availability on October 6th. As I indicated to you, this is contingent upon a prior examination for discovery commitment. I will advise you and the union in respect of the progress thereof on the morning of October 5, 1977.
