Scope and Content Note

The Fewster Papers contain 50cm of textual records. There are 10 manuscripts of poetry and 5 prose manuscripts. The personal material consists of correspondence of Kate Eastman, note book of poetry jottings, an address book and a group photograph.

Biographical Note

Dr. Ernest Fewster was born in England in 1868 and came to Manitoba, Canada in 1887 and to Vancouver in 1888. In 1916 he began the Vancouver Poetry Society of which he became the President. Fewster published six books, five of poetry and one of essays and poems.
