Bio/Admin History: A long-time member of the British Columbia Mountaineering Club and the Vancouver Art and Historical Society, Fred Perry first arrived in Canada in 1904 after apprenticing in the tailor trade in Europe. In 1905 he came to Vancouver where he soon joined several other outdoor enthusiasts in forming the B.C. Mountaineering Club. Perry later helped establish the Burrard Field Naturalists' Club.
Scope/Content: The fonds consists of manuscripts and correspondence pertaining to various aspects of natural history in British Columbia (1919-1947).
