## Introduction

The William Loftus Templeton Collection of Malcolm Lowry manuscripts and related material was donated in his memory by his children -- Kathleen Rennie, Charles B. Templeton, William R. Templeton, Doris Holmes, and Nora Telford. The material will add to our knowledge of the literary activities of Malcolm Lowry. It arrived in 28 folders with a listing of page numbers per folder. Dr. Sherrill Grace, English Department, provided information about the contents of the manuscripts and related material. The material was then arranged into appropriate inventory series.
