Re: Application to Secede

On Friday, February 26th, 1982, the Provincial Executive received a letter and a petition signed by members of AUCE Local 5, requesting that the Provincial Executive commence proceedings in order that the Local may secede from (leave) AUCE Provincial.

The Provincial Constitution requires a full inquiry by the Provincial Executive, as well as a secret ballot referendum of the membership. The inquiry will include at least a questionnaire, a Special Membership Meeting to be conducted by the Provincial Executive, and the referendum.

In the near future, each member of your local will receive a questionnaire outlining AUCE Provincial/AUCE Local 5 related matters. Please think seriously about the questions. The outcome will affect not only the future of your local but will have ramifications for the future of AUCE as a whole. We need the results of the questionnaire before conducting a membership meeting on the matter. The meeting will not take place until the questionnaires have been completed and returned.

The Executive of Local 5 has asked that the inquiry process take place within six weeks. This proposed time frame will be possible if we receive your responses in time to conduct the General Membership Meeting before the end of the month.

The Provincial Executive formed a sub-committee to conduct the inquiry as quickly as possible. Members of the Inquiry Sub-Committee are:
