WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 1976

1. Distribution of Strike Tabloid:

- have been mailed to all AUCE members
- have been distributed at Ubyseeey points on campus by Kitsilano
- Transfer - cost: \$51.65 *10000*
- Data Processing agreed to let us have labels for other staff on payroll for the small sum of 4¢ a label - there are about 5,000 involved, therefore \$200.00 (Connaghan's orders) - this should be considered even though there is considerable cost involved - this newsletter is pretty important
- checked with CUPE and the Faculty Association to see if they could order labels for us - CUPE uses their own addressing system, don't have access to Data Processing labels - the Faculty Association has to meet to decide if they can do this, haven't heard from them yet.

A tape recorder is needed here. We have a whole reserve of thoughts, feelings and ideas in each one of us that goes untapped. How we feel about our work, about each other, about the union, the strike - there's so much valuable material here that goes untouched. I think we should take ourselves seriously enough to make every effort to record, for our own use and other people's, our own experiences - through tapes, photos, interviews, video tapes - whatever means we can get our hands on. We also sporadically conduct seminars and workshops that can be taped for other people's use; grievance seminars, strike seminars, working women's workshops, etc. And music too! Music that talks about our experiences as women and workers: something we can listen to, identify with and ENJOY!

JUDY WRIGHT THAT the Union pay the salaries for one Union member
ROBERT GAYTON at a time to work in the Union Office on short-term
