1. Move that at the April 8th Membership Meeting a standing Organization Committee will be elected consisting of: one elected representative from each Division and a Chairperson of that Committee who will sit on the Executive.

The committees terms of reference are:



- : To organize, maintain and assist shop~~s~~ stewards.
- : To act as a liaison person between the Contract Committee and the shops during negotiations, and in the event a positive strike vote is taken, the standing Organization Committee would become the Strike Committee. At that time, the Strike Committee would call for elections of ¹⁰~~X~~ additional members of the Committee (to be determined by the Strike Committee).

2. *a*. It is recommended that a strike fund be set up.

b. It is recommended that the Executive look into dues assessment based on pro rata earnings.

c. It is recommended to the Executive that they move that a referendum be held to vote on a \$5.00 per member assessment, to be made in July, 1976; such funds to be put into a strike fund.

d. It is recommended that after July, 1976 10% of dues per month be allotted to a strike fund to be kept on deposit in a high yield savings account.

e. In the event of a strike, it is recommended that AUCE Local I authorize the Union to pay out of its treasury, interest on loans for its members who are in dire financial need.
