


SPECIAL SERVICES AND OVERTIME

The fourth paragraph on page 4 of Departmental Memorandum Series D No. 79 (Circular No. 699-C Revised) is hereby cancelled and the following is substituted therefor:

"Officers at limited service ports, outports and preventive stations where the salary is based upon the amount of business, are not entitled to any additional remuneration under these regulations, but, as a temporary measure only, the department will pay overtime to those officers who are actually required to be on duty on customs holidays (excluding Sundays) and who are not precluded, under the regulations, from receiving overtime. Collectors should see that only those officers whose services are absolutely essential on holidays are brought back to work, and that the maximum overtime allowed on one day shall not exceed eight hours".
