THE condition of the within written recognizance is such that whereas one Lee Fook
was this day been charged before me A. F. Pemberton
Stipendiary Magistrate, Justice of the Peace within mentioned, for that he
the said Lee Fook, did on the afternoon of the
3rd day of October 1879, at Commodore Street
in the said City of Victoria, unlawfully assault
one Chui Lay by striking him on the face
and on the head with a piece of iron,

if therefore, he the said Ah Swong shall appear at the
next Court of assizes to be holden in
and for the District or County of City of Victoria, and there
give such evidence as he knoweth upon a Bill of Indictment to be then and there preferred
against the said Lee Fook for the offence
aforesaid, as well to the Jurors who shall there enquire of the said offence, as also to the
Jurors who shall pass upon the trial of the said Lee Fook

if the said Bill shall be found a True Bill,
then the said Recognizance to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
