The term "replacement" shall not apply to terminations or severances. Such student assistants are outside the certification. A student who is hired to regularly work more than 10 scheduled hours a week shall

be considered an employee as defined in section 1 above. Student assistants performing duties normally done by employees bound by this agreement shall be paid at the base hourly rate as outlined in this agreement.
