The first accession of the fonds contains photographs with the identifier format of BC-xxxx. RBSC has since switched its identifier to the format of RBSC-ARC-xxxx-PH-xxxx. The Canadians for Democracy in Chile fonds contains photographs with both the old BC-xxxx identifiers (BC-1963-01 to 11) and new RBSC-ARC-xxxx-PH-xxxx identifiers (RBSC-ARC-1112-PH-01 to 02); photographs with BC numbers have retained those identifiers and have not been

assigned PH identifiers.

Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Note

The Canadians for Democracy in Chile was established in 1973 shortly following Augusto Pinochet's September 11 coup in Santiago, and it continued operations until at least 1989. Philip Rankin served as founding Chair, and William McLeod as founding Secretary-Treasurer with Elspeth Gardner as its first President in 1975. Primary activities of the organization included sponsorship of public meetings and conferences; gathering and dissemination of information on contemporary political conditions in Chile; dispatching medical, material and financial aid to opponents of the Chilean government; and distribution of leaflets, posters, and other publicity and educational materials. In addition, they also sponsored letter writing campaigns, organized fundraising events, and did liaison work with local, national, and international groups including labour unions and human rights organizations, Latin American charity associations, and so on . Canadians for Democracy in Chile designated itself as a `citizen's committee,' and listed its supporters as, alternately, organizer/volunteers, sponsors, or contributing members. The organizing committee was headed by a Chair and a Secretary-Treasurer, and, after 1975, a President. Other organizer/volunteers served on one or more sub-committees, each comprised of between two and five individuals . Sub-committees were formed for "Finance," "Speakers," "Correspondence," "Publicity," and a "Bulletin Committee" to oversee the Canadians for Democracy in Chile newsletter. Members of the

organization commonly abbreviated its full name to C.D.C. Philip Rankin served as founding Chair, and William McLeod as founding Secretary-Treasurer. Elspeth Gardner became first President in 1975.

Custodial history

The initial deposit of materials was made to UBC Library RBSC in early 1990 by Susan Lockhart (née Radosevic), who donated the records on behalf of Canadians for Democracy in Chile around the time of the organization's dissolution. An accrual was donated by Carolina Palacios in September 2022. The accrual was held by Susan Lockhart after the initial deposit; she transferred custody of the accrual materials to Carolina Palacios, who then donated them to UBC Library RBSC.

Scope and content

The fonds consists of administrative records, correspondence, publications, newspaper clippings, and educational and promotional materials related to the operations of the Canadians for Democracy in Chile (C.D.C.) and its relationships with various domestic (Canadian) and international organizations. Records reflect the C.D.C.'s functions as a public information resource and activist organization and its close working relationship with the Vancouver Chile Association and various labour organizations. C.D.C. also regularly corresponded with provincial and federal Canadian government offices concerning Canada's relationship with Chile, particularly its economic relationship. Contents include: posters, leaflets, and other promotional materials for events, conference, and boycotts; published materials (including editions of Chile News, newsletters, and bound copies of conference and UN proceedings); newspaper clippings about activism, Chilean refugees in Canada, and conditions in Chile; correspondence; administrative records; and event photographs.

Arrangement

The records classification system used by the creator from establishment through to 1976 has been preserved by the archivist. Series entitled Administration, Bulletin, Clippings, Correspondence, Miscellaneous, and Publications, accordingly, are comprised of records created between 1973 and 1976. Most of the balance of C.D.C. records had no clear organizational structure upon accession. These records have been arranged in a General series, along with those pre-1977 records found among them at the time of accession. Graphic Materials series has been created on the basis of form. Records in 2 Conferences series were maintained by creator separately from other C.D.C. records.

Date: 1973-1985 (date of creation)

Scope and content:

Series consists of letters sent and received, pertaining to topics including fundraising, membership, liaising with other organizations, and various Canadian provincial and federal government offices. Correspondents include sponsors, contributing members, members of the BC and Federal Canadian governments, members of the Chilean government (frequently Pinochet himself and various Ministers), the United Nations (General Assembly), various BC and international labour unions, and other activist groups concerned with human rights and political issues in Latin America. Creator classified correspondence according to reception or dispatch, and, to some extent, chronologically.

Scope and content:

Series consists of booklets, pamphlets, leaflets, and other published material collected by C.D.C. for purposes of reference and dissemination. Most of this material was produced by North American organizations conducting charity work or human rights agitation in Latin America. Publications include several years of issues of Vinceremos and Chile News.

The C.D.C. employed a mixed scheme to classify publications, storing material in files according to organizations sponsoring publication, the characteristics of organizations sponsoring publications, or the characteristics of the publications themselves.

General Files

<u>Date</u>: 1972-1998; predominant 1977-1989 (date of creation)

Scope and content:

Series consists of publications, clippings, correspondence, event promotion materials (flyers and posters), and administrative records reflecting C.D.C.'s continuing activities following 1976. Series also consists of similar material from earlier era which was found among such records at time of accession. Records include promotional materials and reports on events including speakers and rallies, informational records about the Inter-American Development Bank, open letters and resolutions passed by various committees, and boycott and other labour activism materials.

Arrangement:

Arrangement of the creator has been strictly preserved. Even though much of this series was stored without evident classification, structure, or order, no attempt has been made to place this material

into a classification scheme resembling that of earlier C .D.C. records. A considerable proportion of this series consists of pre-1977 records which were found among post-1976 records at the time of accession . Presumably this material was brought forward for reference purposes during the active life of the records, and never replaced . This material has not been returned to those series to which it evidently was drawn (Clippings, Vancouver Chile Association, Administration, Correspondence, Publications), but remains as ordered at the time of accession. A portion of the General series was maintained according to chronological classification, as is reflected in certain of the file titles . Many among the leaflets, pamphlets, and booklets in this series were stored along with other classes of contemporary records, although some were maintained separately. This latter group of publications now constitutes a Publications file within the General series. This file has been titled 'Publications: Post-1976' in order to distinguish it clearly from the Publications series.

Series consists of registration, booking, financial, and promotional records pertaining to C.D.C. participation in and co-sponsorship of various conferences on contemporary affairs in Chile. Records reflect C.D.C. relations with co-sponsoring bodies, including Amnesty International, the Fraser Valley Peace Committee, the MacKenzie Papineau Battalion Veterans, the Communist Party of Canada, and several labour unions, among others. Contents include invitations to participate, speaker notes, participant notes, itineraries, and travel and other financial records related to participation.
