# Fonds description

### **E.H. Crump Photographic Collection.** – ca. 1910-[196-].

#### Biographical sketch

The collection is attributed to Edward "E.H." Crump (conjecture). As of 1955, Edward Crump was the CPR Agent in Sicamous, B.C.

"E.H." Crump (no dates available) was the elder brother of Norris Roy (N.R., "Buck") Crump (1904-1989).

N.R. Crump was born in Revelstoke, B.C. The father of E.H. and N.R. Crump was the superintendent of the Kettle Valley Division of the Canadian Pacific Railway, and N.R. Crump started working for the railroad at the age of 16 in 1920. N.R. ascended through positions of machinist, track section supervisor, and finally president in 1955. He retired from the CPR from his terminal role of Chairman in 1974.

N.R. Crump was named Companion of the Order of Canada in 1971.

## **Custodial history**

The collection was recovered from Canoe, near Salmon Arm, B.C. in 2018. The photographs were salvaged from the previous residence of George Hohmann, on Shuswap Lake, B.C. Custody was transferred to his brother, Ron Hohmann, who in turn gave the collection to Paige Hohmann, archivist at UBC Okanagan.

## Scope and content

The fonds consists of predominantly of photographs. Photographic coverage includes: N.R. "Buck" Crump as President of the CPR, CPR employees, the 1910 Rogers Pass avalanche, wrecks, fires, steamers, engines, stations, and scenery.

# Notes

### Source of title proper

The reported and inferred provenance of the collection is believed to be to Edward "E.H." Crump, elder brother of N.R. "Buck" Crump. "E.H." worked in Sicamous, B.C., which is adjacent to where the photos were recovered in Canoe B.C. A note on item OSC ARC 10/014 reads "Buck Crump, CEO of CPR. Brother built George's place" See custodial history for further related details.
