## Biographical Sketch

G.W.H. (Hal) Norman graduated with a B.A.Sc. in geology from UBC in 1926. He later received a Ph.D. from Princeton, and went on to work as a geologist and surveyor for the Canadian government and for Newmont Mining.

## Scope and Content

Fonds consists of a “transit book” – a bound notebook used by Hal Norman for notes and measurements taken during his Surveying course in 1923 – and three maps of UBC’s Fairview and Point Grey campuses, hand-drawn in 1923 and plotted in 1976.
