## **Custodial history**

The fonds and its contents were recovered from a dumpster during a home renovation and were kept in storage for several years before being bought by a private bookseller. The bookseller reorganized the fonds before selling them to the UBC Rare Books and Special Collections. The fonds was acquired on February 25, 2012.

## Scope and content

The fonds consists of photographs and textual records which belonged to the Inouye family. The records are related mostly to the father, Zennosuke Inouye and his involvement with the Surrey Berry Farmers Cooperative and his youngest daughter, Kiyooki (Beverly) Inouye. The fonds has been arranged into the

following series: Surrey Berry Farmers Cooperative records, correspondence, ephemera, land records, photographs, military records, financial records, and voting records.

#### Immediate source of acquisition

The fonds was acquired from a local bookseller, Don Stewart of MacLeod's Books in Vancouver, BC.

#### Arrangement

The fonds did not have any evidence of original order. The prior custodian of the fonds rearranged the contents and the extent of this rearrangement is unknown. In addition, some of the materials were not placed in folders and had no apparent order. Arrangement was provided by the archivist.

#### **Related material**

Nikkei Museum in Burnaby, BC has 80 letters by Zennosuke from his campaign to regain his veteran settlement land after the Interment of Japanese-Canadians during WWII and sale of his property and goods to the Custodian. In addition to this, it also has Hatsuno's pattern scrapbook, tracing paper, a quilt, and five duffel bags used to move the family to Kaslo.

## **Series descriptions**

#### **Surrey Berry Growers' Cooperative**

Date: 1931 - 1952 (date of creation)

Scope and content:

Series consists of records related to the Surrey Berry Farmers' Cooperative. The Surrey Berry Farmers' Cooperative is believed to have been Surrey's first berry cooperative and was created sometime in the 1920s. While many of the farmers were Japanese, membership was not restricted by ethnicity. It is unknown when the Surrey Berry Farmers' Cooperative dissolved, but presumably sometime after 1952.

Records in this series include correspondence related to land and property owned by the Cooperative that was confiscated after many of the farmers were interned and their land and property confiscated. Correspondence consists of between Zennosuke Inouye and other members of the Cooperative, between Zennosuke and banks and businesses regarding the Cooperative, and correspondence with a family who helped hide some of the Cooperative's property from the Office of the Custodian. Other records include alist farmers in the Cooperative that purchased Victory Bonds in 1942, a hand-drawn map and list of all the farmers in the Surrey Berry Growers Cooperative in 1941, and accounts and receipts belonging to the Cooperative.

#### **Photographs**

<u>Date</u>: [191-?]-1968 (date of creation)

Scope and content:

Series consists of photographs that feature images of the Inouye's friends and family. Most of the photographs appear to have belonged to Beverly Inouye and picture friends and photos of class photos.

Most of the photographs were loose, but there are 3 albums that have photos. All of the photo albums belonged to Beverly Inouye.

Physical description: 381 photographs: b&w and col.; 13 x 17 on 16 x 23 cm paper and smaller

#### Arrangement:

The majority of the photographs were not contained in an album and were loose. The archivist arranged loose photographs by date if known. If the date was unknown, they were arranged in an undated photographs file. However most of the photographs appear to be from the early-to-mid-twentieth century. If photographs were located in albums, they were kept in the albums.

#### Conservation:

Some of the albums had instances where loose photographs were inserted inside of albums or photographs were coming unglued from their holders. In these cases, the photographs were removed and stored individually in envelopes. They were kept in order and together as they appeared in the album.

#### Military records

Date: 1916 - ? (date of creation)

#### Scope and content:

Series consists of records related to Zennosuke Inouye's military service in World War I. Records include Canadian Legion membership cards, correspondence from when Zennosuke was stationed in Europe, Zennosuke's Active Service Paybook, and photographs of Zennosuke dressed in his military uniform.

Physical description: 2 cm of textual records and 2 photographs; b&w: 14 x 8 cm and 7 x 6 cm

The majority of the correspondence consists of correspondence from Jitsuno Morikawa which was sent before, during, and after his internment experience in the United States.
