## Administrative history / Biographical sketch

---

### Note

Irene Howard is a freelance writer, researcher, broadcaster, literary agent and teacher of English literature. She was born in Prince Rupert, B.C. on November 19, 1922 to a Swedish father and Norwegian mother, and has lived most of her life in British Columbia. She obtained a permanent teaching certificate from the University of Victoria in 1943 and graduated from the University of British Columbia in 1948. She went back to UBC in 1964 and obtained her MA in English, specializing in medieval literature. She taught at the elementary school, college and university levels from 1941-1983. She was a full-time lecturer at UBC from 1964-1965, a full-time instructor at Vancouver City College in 1971, and a full-time instructor at Capilano College from 1977-1983.

Howard's interest in her Swedish heritage led her to write her first book, *Vancouver's Svenskar: A History of the Swedish Community in Vancouver* published by the Vancouver Historical Society in 1970. She published several articles on the life and work of Vancouver writer Ethel Wilson (1888-1980). She researched and wrote an article about the Branvolds, "The Brandvolts of Diamond Head," who developed the Diamond Head area of Garibaldi Mountain in the 1940s and 1950s. She had a great interest in aural history research, and taped interviews of members and survivors of Vancouver's turn-of-the-century "high society" families which culminated in an article called "High Tea: Society in the Old West End." In 1992, she wrote a biography of social reformer Helena Gutteridge, the first woman elected to Vancouver City Council in 1912. Howard was also the literary agent and editor for Ronald Liversedge and worked on his unpublished manuscript, *A Memoir of the Spanish Civil War*. She went on to publish other books, such as one on Bowen Island in 1973 and one based on her family history called *Gold Dust on His Shirt*.

Irene Howard is also a member of several organizations, such as the Vancouver International Folkdancers, and was a candidate agent for the B.C. New Democratic Party in 1996. Her interests included issues

---

relating to the Royal Commission on the Status of Women, nuclear disarmament, the peace movement and the Vancouver West End Tenant Association.

## Scope and content

---

The Irene Howard fonds consists of general correspondence and materials related to Howard's personal interests and associations, and materials relating to her work as researcher, literary agent and writer. The fonds is divided into eight series: Association involvement and general interest; Interview recordings; Photographs and maps; "Monday Morning" magazine issues; Literary activities; NDP campaigns materials; Materials related to Ronald Liversedge; and Gold dust on his shirt publication records. The Gold dust series is further subdivided into Publication records and Research records. The fonds includes research notes, notebooks, file cards, photocopied materials from various sources, correspondence (with publishers, research subjects, colleagues, librarians and archivists), drafts of Howard's books and essays, biographical materials, newsletters, magazines, newspaper clippings, articles, pamphlets, brochures, photographs and cassette tapes.

Material was first transferred by Irene Howard on October 5, 1984 and officially gifted in January 6, 1986. Subsequent accruals were added in 2006 and in 2012.

### Arrangement

The RAD-compliant description was prepared by Sergey Kovynev, Lisa Snider and Lindsay Szymanski in December, 2009 based on the existing arrangement. The finding aid was updated to include the records donated in the 2012 accrual by Katie Sloan in June, 2015.

### Association involvement and general interest files

Scope and content:

The materials included in the series are associated with Howard's Brief to the Royal Commission on the Status of Women in March 1968, involvement with the nuclear disarmament and peace movements, the West End Tenant's Association, the Vancouver International Folkdancers, and with her interest in aural history. The series also include notes on members of the Malkin family and Ethel Wilson and notes and transcripts of various interviews with Mom's Repairs. Irene Howard's biographical material, such as CVs and lists of publications and talks, are also presented in the series.

### Records related to literary activities

Date: 1879 - 2004, predominately 1967 – 1982 (date of creation)

Scope and content:

Series includes materials related to Howard's book *Vancouver Svenskar: A History of the Swedish Community in Vancouver* and research on Swedes in Canada and in B.C., to Irene Howard's activities as editor and literary agent for Ronald Liversedge and his unpublished memoir *Memoirs of the Spanish Civil War*, to her involvement in the Writer's Union of Canada. The material included in the series also pertains to Howard's research and articles on the Bravolds of Diamond Head, Helen Gutteridge, Ethel Wilson and on "high society" in Vancouver's West End at the turn of the century with transcripts of taped interviews with Joseph Malkin, Lila Molson, Elspeth Cherniavsky, Mrs. A. W. Bell-Irving, H.R. Clyne and Gardner S. Eldridge. There is also correspondence from Arne Johnson regarding lumber unions, a Swedish pamphlet on the Industrial Workers of the World, and two black and white publicity photos of Irene Howard in this series.

Scope and content:

Series includes materials related to Howard's book *Gold Dust On His Shirt: The True Story of an Immigrant Mining Family*. The book is described as being "part family history, part economic and social history," which examines "life on the industrial frontier, the world of immigrant workers and the rise of unions such as the Wobblies. This remarkable and provocative tale of a family, region and era references a number of broader social and political issues" (from back cover).

The series contains records related to the publication of *Gold Dust*. The series is subdivided into two subseries: Publishing records and Research records. The Publication records subseries contains records related to the publishing of *Gold Dust*, such as correspondence, contracts,

manuscripts, and chapter drafts. The Research records subseries contains records Howard consulted when writing her book such as archival material, book notes, maps, and pamphlets.
