Biographical Sketch

Josef (Joe) Schlesinger was a Canadian foreign correspondent, television journalist, and author. He was born to a devout Jewish family in Vienna, Austria, in 1928, and raised in Bratislava, Czechoslovakia (now Slovakia). After Czechoslovakia was occupied by Nazi Germany in 1938, he and his younger brother Ernest were sent to England by his parents as part of the *Kindertransport*, organized by Englishman Nicholas Winton, that rescued 669 Jewish children. His parents were later killed in the Holocaust. Schlesinger would later appear in and narrate the 2011 documentary *Nicky's Family* about Winton and the *Kindertransport*.

Schlesinger pursued a journalism career after the war, first working at the Prague bureau of the Associated Press in 1948 as a translator. He fled Czechoslovakia again in 1950, after its Communist government began arresting journalists. He emigrated to Canada, arriving at Pier 21 in Halifax and travelling to Vancouver to join his brother, who had emigrated to Canada earlier under the Canadian Jewish War Orphans Project.

After studying at the University of British Columbia and editing *The Ulysses*, Schlesinger started reporting for the *Vancouver Province* newspaper, before moving to the *Toronto Daily Star*. He then left Canada and edited for United Press International in London and the *International Herald Tribune* in Paris.

It was in Paris that Schlesinger met Myra “Mike” Kemmer, who was stationed there as a U.S. Foreign Service officer. They married and eventually had two daughters, Léah and Ann. Mike Schlesinger was primarily responsible for the preservation of Joe’s news scripts and other materials related to his professional life. As Léah Schlesinger later wrote:

[S]he supported him, stood by him and was incredibly, incredibly proud of him. As anyone who knows him even slightly has heard him say, she was the center of his life... she was the force that kept him grounded when all else was chaos and loss. [She was] both the person who stood by his side during all those decades, and ... the person who lovingly archived all of these documents for posterity... because she believed in the importance of what he did and the passion with which he did it.

After Mike died in 2001 Joe penned a heartfelt obituary that was published in the *Globe and Mail*.

Schlesinger returned to Canada in 1966 and joined the CBC, eventually becoming executive producer of *The National* and providing occasional on-air commentary on world news events. However, he left his management position and returned to reporting in 1970, moving to Hong Kong as the CBC's Far East correspondent. He would go on to serve as the CBC's senior foreign correspondent in various assignments around the world: China, Vietnam, Europe, Iran, the United States, Nicaragua, Africa, and the Middle East, to name a few. In 1989 he returned to Czechoslovakia to report on the Velvet Revolution in Prague, when the country's Communist government fell.

In 1990, Joe Schlesinger published his autobiography, *Time Zones: a Journalist in the World*, which became a bestseller. After reporting on the 1990-91 Gulf War he returned to Canada, and was appointed chief political correspondent for *The National*. He was later promoted to managing editor of CBC News, producing commentaries and documentaries for CBC's *Prime Time News*. He retired as a full-time reporter in 1994 but continued to produce essays and special reports for CBC News. Later that decade he hosted several foreign news magazine programmes on CBC Newsworld, including *Foreign Assignment* (shared with Ian Hanomansing), and *Schlesinger*. He continued to produce occasional documentaries for CBC and write commentaries for the CBC News website until he was well into his eighties. For example, in 2015 he wrote about the plight of Syrian refugees seeking asylum in Canada – as a former refugee himself he urged Canadians to show compassion rather than fear and resentment. His final piece for the CBC was published in September 2016, on that year's U.S. presidential election.

During the course of his career Schlesinger was nominated for 18 Gemini Awards, winning three: "Best Reportage" (1987, 1992), and "Best News Magazine Segment" (2004). He also received the Gordon Sinclair Award for "Best Performance by a Broadcast Journalist" (1987), and the John Drainie ACTRA Award (1997), and received a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Canadian Journalism Foundation in 2009. In 2016, he was inducted to the CBC News Hall of Fame. Schlesinger also received honorary doctorates from UBC (1992), the Royal Military College of Canada (1997), Dalhousie University (2000), Carleton University (2010), Queen's University (2010), and the University of Alberta (2011). He was named a Member of the Order of Canada in 1994.

After his "retirement" Joe Schlesinger lived in Toronto with his second wife, Judith Levene. He died in 2019, at the age of 90, after a long illness.

Custodial History

Joe Schlesinger's wife Mike ensured that his papers were kept together during his career. After their deaths his personal and professional archive was maintained in storage by their daughter Léah Schlesinger in California, until its donation to the University Archives in 2021.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of materials in various media created or acquired by Joe Schlesinger in the course of his professional career, along with materials documenting or commemorating the *Kindertransport* programme, and a few items of a more personal nature. It includes textual records such as scripts for his news reports and speeches, correspondence, notebooks, scrapbooks, newspaper and magazine clippings, honorary degrees and other awards, published items, posters, and miscellaneous writings. Also included are photographs, audiovisual recordings, and digital files.

The fonds is arranged in the following series: Scripts, Speeches, Correspondence, Notebooks, Scrapbooks, Clippings (sub-series Pieces by Schlesinger, Pieces about Schlesinger, and Other Pieces), Awards and Recognition, *Time Zones*, Winton/*Kindertransport*, Miscellaneous, Photographs, Audiovisual, and Digital Media.

Series Descriptions

Scripts series. –1966-1986, 2013-2014.

49 cm of textual records.

Series consists of typescripts of Joe Schlesinger's television news reports (1966-86), and printouts of his commentaries written for the CBC News and CBC Newsworld websites. Files are maintained in chronological order.

The scripts are typed on either "onion-skin" paper or script paper. Many are carbon copies, and most have written edits on them. In many cases several versions of the same script are retained, to take into account Schlesinger's last-minute edits.

Speeches series. – 1982-2011.

12 cm of textual records.

Series consists of typescripts of speeches made by Schlesinger at various events, including his several honorary degree ceremonies. Files are maintained in chronological order.

Correspondence series. – 1990-2010.

Series consists of items of correspondence addressed to and kept by Schlesinger, mostly regarding his professional relationships and career milestones. Items may be handwritten, typewritten, or printed from e-mail. Files are maintained in chronological order.

Series consists of Schlesinger's appointment book for 1991, and three undated spiral notebooks.

Scrapbooks series. – 1955-1968.

6 cm of textual records.

Series consists of three scrapbooks containing newspaper clippings documenting Schlesinger's work with different newspapers, including the *Vancouver Province*, the *Toronto Star*, and the *International Herald-Tribune*. Files are maintained in chronological order.

The volumes are in fragile physical condition, with many pages loose, and are to be handled with care by staff and researchers.

Box 7

Clippings series. – 1960-2018.

Series consists of newspaper and magazine clippings, photocopied articles, website printouts, other published items, and manuscripts. It is arranged in three sub-series: Pieces by Schlesinger, Pieces about Schlesinger, and Other Pieces. Files are maintained in chronological order.

Sub-series consists of written work by Schlesinger, in the form of clippings, periodicals, website printouts, and manuscripts.

Pieces about Schlesinger sub-series. – 1960-2009.
6 cm of textual records.

Sub-series consists of published written work by other journalists about Schlesinger, in the form of clippings, periodicals, website printouts, and photocopies.

Box 8

Other Pieces series. – 1962-1998.

1 cm of textual records.

Sub-series consists of written work by other journalists collected by Schlesinger, in the form of clippings and other published items. Items either mention Schlesinger in passing, or were likely otherwise of interest to him.

Box 8

Awards and Recognition series. – 1992-2011.

4.5 cm of textual records.

Series consists of materials that document awards, honorary degrees, and other forms of recognition received by Schlesinger during his life, and includes original certificates, citations, and ceremonial programmes. Files are maintained in chronological order.

Some certificates were removed from their frames during processing.

Box 8

Time Zones series. – 1989-1990.

2 cm of textual records.

Series consists of materials documenting the publication and promotion of Schlesinger's memoir *Time Zones: A Journalist in the World*, and includes correspondence, clippings, itineraries and brochures for Schlesinger's promotional tour in support of his book. Files are maintained in chronological order.

Box 9

Winton/Kindertransport series. – 1940, 1988-2015.

10 cm of textual records.

Series consists of materials documenting Nicholas Winton's *Kindertransport* project, as well as Schlesinger's involvement in documenting and publicizing the *Kindertransport* many years later. Winton's efforts rescued hundreds of Jewish children from European countries under occupation by Nazi Germany in 1938 and 1939 – Joe Schlesinger was one of them, and his name is on the list in File 9-7. Materials also include scripts and transcripts for the documentaries *Nicholas Winton: The power of good* and *Nicky's Children*, correspondence, copies of published articles about Winton and the *Kindertransport*, and related items. Files are maintained in chronological order.

Box 9

Miscellaneous series. – 1974-2018.

6 cm of textual records.

1 framed item.

Series consists of materials that document Schlesinger's professional career but which don't fit into any other series, and includes a framed poster, several other oversized posters, promotional materials from the CBC, clippings, Schlesinger's professional membership cards, and the typescript of a speech given at his 90th birthday (author unknown). Files are maintained in chronological order.

Box 10

Photographs series. – 1966-2011.

95 photographic prints, various sizes.

Series consists of photographic prints documenting Schlesinger's life, career, and travels. Some photographs were taken by Schlesinger, but most were taken by others and show Schlesinger either on foreign assignment or at other events.

Audiovisual series. – 1971-2019.

260 video recordings, various formats.

1 audio recording.

Series consists of audiovisual recordings that document Schlesinger's work. Most are recordings of TV broadcasts of his news reports, interviews, and commentaries. Others are original recordings.

Some of the materials in this series depict war scenes. User discretion is advised.

Includes 206 VHS tapes, 38 DVDs, 10 U-Matic L tapes, 1 U-Matic s tape, 4 Betacam s tapes, 1 Betacam sp tape, and 1 audio cassette tape.
