Fonds description

Len Bawtree fonds. – 1970-1983.

2m of textual records and other materials

Biographical sketch

Len Bawtree (1924-2014) was born and raised in Ashton Creek, east of Enderby, BC. After enlisting in the Royal Canadian Air Force in World War II and marrying Ruth Swaby in 1944, Bawtree came back to the Okanagan and logged and raised cattle for beef on his farm. He was a founding member of the North Okanagan Livestock Association and the long-time director of the BC Cattleman's Association. When regional districts were created in the 1960's, Bawtree was appointed the first representative from rural Enderby to the North Okanagan Regional District. He was elected to the BC Legislature in 1975 when Bill Bennett's Social Credit Party defeated Dave Barrett's NDP government. He was re-elected in the next election but lost the nomination in the following election.

Custodial history

The fonds was moved from the residence of his daughter to Enderby and District Museum and Archives (EDMA). EDMA then donated the fonds to UBCO in 2018.

Scope and content

The fonds consists of records relating to Bawtree's time on two important legislative committees: The Committee on Crown Corporations and The Select Standing Committee on Agriculture (SSCA). The SSCA was tasked by the Legislature to make a complete review of agriculture in the province, including the production, processing and distribution of food products within the province. As a result, there are reports from numerous meetings taken throughout different cities in BC from various agricultural groups that aided in the different phases of the research report on the entire food system of BC. These records include: bounded reports, transcripts, photographs, correspondence, expense reports, articles, and handwritten notes.

Summary: The fonds consists of records relating to Bawtree's time on two important legislative committees: The Committee on Crown Corporations and The Select Standing Committee on Agriculture (SSCA). The SSCA was tasked by the Legislature to make a complete review of agriculture in the province, including the production, processing and distribution of food products within the province. As a result, there are reports from numerous meetings taken throughout different cities in BC from various agricultural groups that aided in the different phases of the research report on the entire food system of BC. These records include: bounded reports, transcripts, photographs, correspondence, expense reports, articles, and handwritten notes.

Biography/history note: Len Bawtree (1924-2014) was born and raised in Ashton Creek, east of Enderby, B.C. After enlisting in the Royal Canadian Air Force in World War II and marrying Ruth Swaby in 1944, Bawtree came back to the Okanagan and logged and raised cows for beef on his farm. He was a founding member of the North Okanagan Livestock Association and the long-time director of the BC Cattleman's Association. When regional districts were created in the 1960's, Bawtree was appointed the first representative from rural Enderby to the North Okanagan Regional District. He was elected to the BC Legislature in 1975 when Bill Bennett's Social Credit Party defeated Dave



Barrett's NDP government. He was re-elected in the next election but lost the nomination in the following election.
