## **Biographical Sketch**

Nathan T. Nemetz was born in Winnipeg in 1913 and moved to Vancouver when he was 10. Nemetz attended the University of British Columbia and graduated in 1934. He was very involved with the UBC community for his entire life following his graduation. He was a member of the UBC Senate, chaired the Board of Governors from 1965-1968, received the Great Trekker Award in 1969, was the Chancellor of the University from 1972-1975, received an honorary Doctor of Laws in 1975 and served as a Chancellor Emeritus following his term. Nemetz studied law and joined the British Columbia Bar in 1936. He was made Supreme Court Justice of the British Columbia in 1963 and a Justice of the Court of Appeal in 1968. He was made the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of British Columbia in 1973 and the Chief Justice of British Columbia in 1979 a position he held until his retirement in 1988.

## **Scope and Content**

The fonds consists of legal decisions, arbitration reports, letters, speeches, certificates, VHS video recordings, photographs and two photo albums.

## Series Descriptions

**Legal Decisions series.** - 1964-1988.

15.25 cm. of textual material.

Series consists of written legal decisions that Nemetz made as a judge. The majority are Judicial Decisions and Opinions from court proceeding, but there are a few arbitration decisions and one procedural report. Textual documents are ordered in Nemetz's original filing order.

Box 1

**Speeches and Personal Interests series.** - 1948-1991.

30 cm. of textual material.

Series consists of speeches Nemetz gave through his positions as a judge, leadership of UBC, and personal tributes to other members of the community. The series also includes a few files related to Nemetz's personal interests that informed some of his thoughts expressed in the speeches. Speeches are ordered in Nemetz's original filing order.

**Photos and Albums series.** - 1963-1992.
