## Administrative history / Biographical sketch

#### Note

Thomas Kingston Fleming was born on March 2nd 1926 in Sardis, British Columbia to Philip and Marjorie Fleming. He had two brothers, Frank and Peter Fleming. He attended Victoria College and University of British Columbia, where he earned his degree in Commerce. Fleming was an entrepreneur, founder of Vintage Consultants, creator of the Kaatza Foundation, and had a long career with Balfour Forest Products. He was a trained chartered accountant, a supporter of education, and an amateur historian of British Columbia, the Pacific Northwest, and Canada.

## **Scope and content**

The Thomas K. Fleming research collection consists of materials related to the settler colonial history of British Columbia, and more broadly, the Pacific Northwest and Canada. Record types include correspondence, newsletters, press clippings, printed materials, notes, maps, legal documents, as well as Fleming's stamp collection and associated records. Historical records in the collection include content primarily from the nineteenth to early twentieth century on such subjects as forestry, travel, commerce,

and postal history. The collection has been arranged into two series: Historical Records and Research Subject Files series, and Stamp Collection and Related Materials series.

## **Series descriptions**

### Historical records and research subject files

Date: 1861-1999 (date of creation)

#### Scope and content:

The series consists of historical records acquired by Fleming as well as research subject files he created in his study of British Colombian history. Subjects include the Alaska American/Canadian border dispute, British Columbia settler colonial history, the forestry and timber industry, trade and commerce in the Pacific Northwest, and particularly the Nootka crisis and the expedition of Alessandro Malaspina. Record types include correspondence, indentures, pamphlets, articles, notes, presentation materials, and photographs from Fleming's research related travel.
