INTRODUCTION

The Service, Office, and Retail Workers Union of Canada (SORWUC) was established in 1972 in order to organize workers in banks, restaurants, and offices— areas where many of the workers are women. It certified some financial institutions, most of which applied later for de-certification. SORWUC gained public attention in 1978 and the union became involved in the Muckamuck Restaurant dispute that developed into a long dispute between workers and management that was never resolved.

SORWUC was noted as a strong advocate for women's rights. It disbanded in 1986. The records the union donated in 1987 were those from the Local 1 Office located at #305-402 West Pender St., Vancouver, B.C. In addition to correspondence, legal records, minutes, and printed material, the records contain material relating to agreements with Distacom Ltd. and Bobolink Daycare-- two bargaining units which were certified with SORWUC. The records of Local 4, Bank and Finance Workers, were donated separately and have their own inventory.
