4. That over three fourths in value of my unsecured creditors have signed the annexed resolution, amounting to \$1844.

The 11<sup>th</sup> day of August 1870

We the undersigned whose names are written in the Schedule hereto and creditors of the said Bankrupt being of opinion that it will be beneficial for the creditors of the said Bankrupt that all further proceedings under an adjudication of Bankruptcy made on the fifth day of April 1870 against the said Bankrupt should be stayed and that the estate of the said Bankrupt should be wound up under a deed of arrangement, do hereby resolve that the estate of the said Bankrupt ought to be and shall be (if the court shall think fit) wound up and administered in manner following That is to say that the said Ernest Miller shall execute a deed covenanting to pay fifty cents in the dollar as soon as he is in a position to do so, and it is further resolved that the said Ernest Miller (with the consent of the court) shall receive from the court the balance standing to the credit of the estate:-
