We wish to refer to Article Vil of the new Canadian-German payment agreement (use of Compensation, Aski, or Blocked Marks in connection with Canadian-German trade) and to advise you that on the basis of information we have received in this connection it appears that no merchandise orders placed in Germany after November 14th, 1936 are likely to be permitted to be paid for in Registered Marks, or presumably other forms of "controlled" Mark balances. Furthermore, we are led to believe that all such transactions closed prior to November 14th, 1936 will have to be liquidated not later than March 31st, 1937. (*Het would be fine ! He fuck boat annie 15-25 april*) = FF
