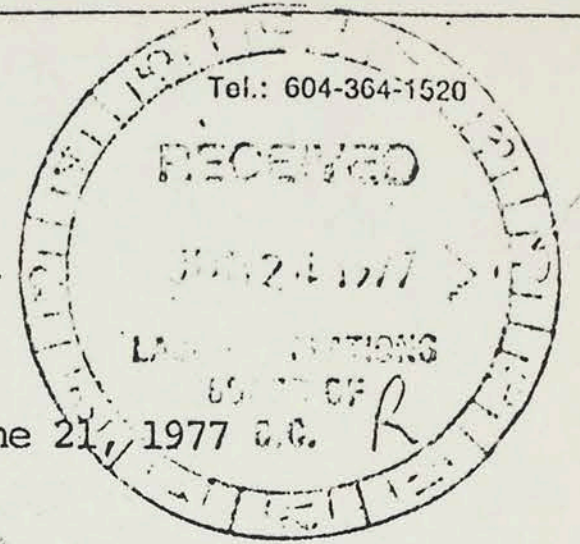


On June 1, 1977 the Province of British Columbia purchased all assets and liabilities of the University of Notre Dame, in Nelson, B.C. The name of the University was changed to David Thompson University. To our knowledge an agreement has been signed between the Province and Selkirk College, Castlegar. Selkirk College has assumed the operation and its employees.

The Canadian Union of Public Employees and its Local 1341, has the bargaining rights for employees of Selkirk College under two certifications dated December 2, 1969 and November 1, 1966, varied February 23, 1971.

The Union requests the Board to make a ruling under Sections 54, and 34, to clarify the bargaining rights of C.U.P.E. Local 1341. The employees of Notre Dame University are presently covered by the Collective Agreement, with The Association of University and College Employees, Local No. 3.

Selkirk College and the Union have discussed this matter and do not agree on a solution for take over, as it relates to collective bargaining.
