Dear Lissett:

In response to your letter of September 25, 1982 inquiring about the requirements to retain your membership in AUCE, it is my interpretation that your membership is automatically in place for 250 days from your last dues deduction. It is not necessary for you to pay any dues during this period.

I hadn't forgotten that you wanted your status confirmed in writing. I did, however, want to wait to send you the information until after the Provincial Convention on September 26-27. As a result of that Convention the total constitution was revised. I am enclosing the pertinent section of both the old constitution and the new one. You can see the changes.

The AUCE Local 1 By-Laws (section enclosed) are now out of line and will have to be amended accordingly. There is no longer any per capita tax and as you can see our by-laws only requested that per capita tax be maintained. I think this would now no longer be appropriate.
