HISTORY

William Augustus Edye DeHurst, is about 70, single, a native of England has resided here since about 1929. During the intervening period he has followed the present line but indications are that returns have not been large and on December 17, 1938 a judgment was recorded against him in favour of Robert Scharffe for \$159.

METHOD OF OPERATION

Cultivates tree seeds, selling mostly for a foreign market on a credit basis. Premises are of the usual greenhouse type situated in the suburbs known as North Kamloops.

FIRE HAZARD

Owns the two-storey building which is in good repair and adjoined by a well maintained residence. The entire building is used for the purpose of seed extraction and premises are neat.

FIRE RECORD: No fires reported.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

He does not reply to a recent request for figures, but it is learned that his principal assets comprise his dwelling worth \$1,000 and the one-storey frame seed mill worth about \$500. He has a few hundred dollars invested in tools and equipment but cash is low and he is said to have comparatively debts. He has apparently extended large amounts of credit in the past and at the present time is said to be owing heavily on borrowed money.

On August 21, 1937 he gave an assignment of book accounts to the Royal Bank of Canada.

DeHurst lives economically but this business keeps him occupied only about two months in each year and returns are proportionately small. Sells principally to the foreign market and owing to competition has found it necessary to extend large amounts of credit upon which he has been unable to realize.

PAYMENTS

The account in local quarters has been found very slow pay.

SUMMARY

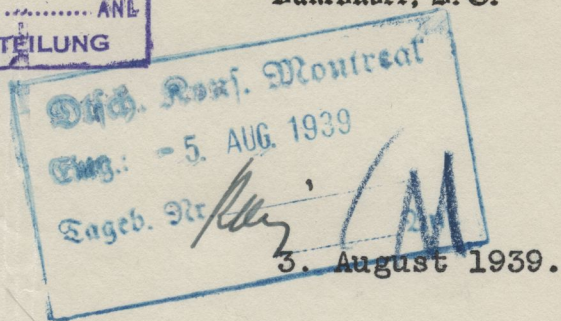
