French Armament Firm **Considers Establishing Here**

MONTREAL.—Schneider-Creusot, time ago. We many know more in a month or two. the great French armament firm, and former part owners of the Skoda works in Czecho-Slovakia, may come to Sorel or Montreal. Negotiations are in progress, says Jos. Simard, head of Marine Industries Ltd., but no definite information is available as yet.

"I have been negotiating with the Schneider-Creusot interests," said Mr. Simard, "to get more work for Sorel, to add some new lines, owing to the irregularity with which we get ship contracts.

"My brother and I were in France last year, and we talked with Mr. Schneider. We are still working on that.

"Later Mr. Schneider came to Montreal and to Sorel, and visited us, to see what could be done.

Prospects Are Better "I can tell you that prospects of something being done are a lot better now than they were some

"We want to bring new industries,

We want to bring new industries, and new work, not alone to Sorel, but to Montreal and to Canada, in fact," he said. "We therefore are trying our best to make a deal, to see if they cannot use our technical knowledge, or whatever they may need, in co-op-eration here to produce what is re-nuired. quired.

"But I repeat again, there is noth-ing definite yet. But I hope we may have some news for you later."
