EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS last year's AUCE Convention voted to seek direct affiliation as AUCE to the CLC and failing this, anAUCE Special Convention be called to discuss further terms of affiliation to the CLC, and

MHEREAS Merger with the three possible CLC unions, MHEREAS Merger with the three possible CLC unions, the CCU, SORWUC, and continued direct CLC affiliation attempts have been investigated,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the AUCE Special Convention set the following referendum ballot on this matter:


- I. A four-part union-wide referendum commence as soon as possible and be conducted until 5:00 p.m. May 29, 1980 and counted on May 30, 1980.
- II. Final ratification of any negotiations with another labour body shall be approved or rejected by the ANCE membership by referendum ballot.
- III. That each local's ballots be printed on different coloured paper and tabulated separately, local by local.
- IV. The actual form of the referendum ballot in I would be as follows and would be accompanied by a brief explanatory letter:

AUCE hold one referendum ballot of its entire membership to ask if they are in favour of affiliation to the CLC through joining an affiliate union.


