M E M O R A N D U M

To Collector of Customs and Excise,
and others concerned:

BRITISH PREFERENTIAL TARIFF AND BENEFITS
OF THE AUSTRALIAN TRADE AGREEMENT, 1931,
EXTENDED TO PAPUA AND NORFOLK ISLAND.

Referring to Section 4 of the Customs Tariff Act, you are advised that by Order in Council (P.C. 2413), dated the 29th September, 1937, it is ordered that on and after the 1st October, 1937, and for such time as the Trade Agreement between Canada and Australia, 1931, remains in force, there be extended to goods the growth, produce or manufacture of Papua and Norfolk Island the benefits of the British Preferential Tariff and of such rates of Customs duty more favourable than those of the said British Preferential Tariff as have been or hereafter may be extended to goods the growth, produce or manufacture of the Commonwealth of Australia.
