Dear Mr. Grant:

With respect to the Industrial First Aid Regulations and the Industrial Health & Safety Regulations of the Workers' Compensation Board of B.C. the Union has some concerns we would like to raise with you.

1. Are people working in the Health Sciences Centre being tested for tuberculosis (see Section 78.31 of the Regulations)?
2. Can you confirm that the emergency unit in the Acute Care Hospital is available to university employees? We imagine one of the reasons there are not more first aid attendants or first aid rooms is accessibility to the hospital here at UBC.
3. Could you advise us what university policy is as far as first aid people is concerned. Would they receive an additional amount on top of their salary each month?
4. If a university employee was taken to emergency for treatment would they then be admitted there if necessary?

Finally, from 4.04(1) of the regulations would you advise us who the Chairman and Secretary of the University Health & Safety Committee is? and can you confirm for us that the number of employees on the committee is equal to that of the employer ((b) and (c) of the above section of the regulations).

Thank you for your assistance in the above matters.
