 me by the Bankrupt - I find the following

Outstanding debts due to the Estate
 amount to \$20,687. 38

of this amount the Bankrupt says there is
 \$3219. 56 1/2 very doubtful, if not positively
 Bad. — \$17,467. 81 1/2 positively Bad, and
 no good debts whatever

These debts are for goods sent to Bankrupt

Columbia and sold to debtors resident there extending
over a period of from 3 to 4 Years. - Some
of these debtors are Bankrupt - Some have
absconded, and others deceased. But his list
there appears to be no debts due to the Estate
by parties resident on the Island - and the
Bankrupt says there are none.

The Bankrupt further says that all
moneys which he has rec^d for some months past
have been expended chiefly in payment of
Interest and for Store and House Expenses,
The amount Monthly paid for Interest to
States at over - \$200.00 - and for Store
and House Charges at 400⁰⁰ per month.
