TARIFF CHANGE BY ORDER IN COUNCIL

By Order in Council (P.C. 2230), dated the 15th September, 1937, passed under the authority of Section 284 of the Customs Act, the following regulation is made and established:

REGULATION

The undermentioned product, when imported for the specified purpose, is subject to the tariff treatment hereunder indicated for the period named:

"Coal tar benzol, when imported by refiners of crude petroleum for use only in blending with gasoline wholly produced in Canada: Until the 31st December, 1937:

British Preferential Tariff.....Free
Intermediate Tariff.....10 p.c.
General Tariff.....20 p.c."

(to be designated as Tariff Item 827)

The Order in Council referred to is effective on and after the 18th September, 1937, the date of publication in the "Canada Gazette".
