Whereas, *Simon a ben Westminster, India* was this day charged before me,
Augustus Beaumont Esq's one of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the said

Colony of Vancouver Island and its Dependencies, on the oath of *Patrick Ferrall*
 of *Victoria* and others, for that *he the said Simon*

on the night of the 27th day of July, or the morning of the 28th day of July
1866, at Victoria in the Colony aforesaid, feloniously, wilfully,
and of his malice aforethought, did kill and murder one Edmund
Wren, against the peace your Lady the Queen her crown and
deputy, and contrary to the form of the Statute in such case
made and provided

These are therefore to command you, the said Constable of Victoria, to take the said
Simon and him safely to convey to the Common Gaol at Victoria aforesaid, and

there to deliver him to the keeper thereof, together with this precept; and I do hereby command you the said
 keeper of the said Common Gaol to receive the said *Simon*

into your custody in the said Common Gaol and there safely keep him until he shall be thence delivered by
 due course of law.
