the said Sharley then and
there feloniously wilfully
and of his malice aforesaid
did shoot and discharge and
that the said Quarish with
the leaden bullets aforesaid
out of the gun aforesaid
then and there by force of the
Gunpowder shot and sent forth
as aforesaid the said Sharley
in and upon the shoulder of
him the said Sharley then
and there feloniously wilfully
and of his malice aforesaid
did strike penetrate and wound
giving to the said Sharley
then and there with the

aforethought did kill and
Murder against the Peace of
our Lady The Queen Her Crown
and Dignity.
