Dear Doctor Wagner,

I have your letter of the 7th instant, inquiring on behalf of Messrs. B. Hoogen and Company, Duellen, Germany, with respect to the Tariff status of linen harness cord.

From the information submitted it would appear that the harness cord in question would be subject to duty under Tariff Item 537a at 22½% ad valorem, Intermediate Tariff.

Importations under this Item, when imported from Germany in accordance with the Trade Agreement regulations, are subject to the Intermediate Tariff rate quoted.

Such importations are also liable to the Consumption or Sales Tax of 8% and the special Excise Tax of 3%, both of which are levied on the Customs duty paid value.
