This is to advise you that I hereby resign my position of President of A.U.C.E. Local 1, effective the above date.

My reasons are: I find I can no longer, in good conscience support the position taken by the membership of A.U.C.E. Local 1 at the membership meeting of today, and I am completely unable to reconcile my own personal views with those of the majority of the Membership. Thus I am completely incapable of carrying out the wishes of the Membership, and am therefore resigning.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL I RECONSIDER THE POSITION I AM TAKING, AND WOULD BE GRATEFUL IF THE MEMBERS OF THE UNION WOULD NOT ATTEMPT TO ENGAGE ME IN FRUITLESS DISCUSSION OF MY DECISION.
