AGENCY DEADLINE: 15 August, 1985 and 15 January 1985

The purpose of the Fund is to support demonstration projects and applied research that will increase the understanding of the human and social impact of technological change in Canada. The fund is designed to support workplace-related projects that will have a clear and practical impact on the management of technological change.

Studies in a broad range of subjects would be appropriate for funding under this program. The range of subjects could include, but is not restricted to:

- \*health and safety
- \*ergonomics
- \*labour-management relations
- \*unions and unionism
- \* job satisfaction
- \* compensation
- \* working conditions

Projects will be funded up to a total of two years, for a maximum amount of \$100,000
