## PAY SCHEDULE

### Pickers' Pay Schedule

At the April 29th Special Membership Meeting the following motion was passed:

That the membership of AUCE Local #1 hereby authorizes the Secretary-Treasurer to pay strike pay only to those members who perform picket or alternate duty. In the event that a member performs some of her/his duty, but not all, the rate of pay will be on a pro rata basis.

Our goal is to pay picketers as accurately, fairly and quickly as possible. To ensure that we succeed and that you get paid on Thursday, May 15, 1980 please bring your pay stub to the Union Office as soon as possible (or have your picket co-ordinator bring it into the Office). At that point we will xerox it, return the original to you or your co-ordinator, and begin calculating your pay. If you fulfilled your picketing commitment you will receive your regular net pay on May 15th; otherwise your pay will be determined on a pro-rata basis.

There will obviously be great difficulties in determining if every member has in fact fulfilled the required commitment. Please bear with us and forgive any possible errors - they can always be rectified. If you have any questions try to put them in writing and direct them to the Secretary-Treasurer and/or the Union Office.

Please deliver or bring your pay stubs to the AUCE Local #1 Union Office (2162 Western Parkway - above the Health Food Store and beside the B.C. Teachers' Credit Union in the University Village Square) by Wednesday, if possible.

If you get your pay stub to the Union Office within a reasonable period of time your pay cheque will be ready for you to pick up on Thursday, May 15th. If there is some delay on your part then your pay cheque probably will not be ready for Thursday. In any case you will be paid.

Many thanks for holding in there and being so patient. Your picketing efforts are necessary to ensure that we get a good agreement.
