Dear Lid,

As per our phone call this morning, I am enclosing a list of the charges for employee benefits for the month of November, 1981. As you can see, in all cases, the charges for you are for the months of October and November. Please forward a cheque in the amount of \$504.42 to this office.

For your information, for the medical and dental premiums, you must pay one-half of the amount indicated and your employer must pay the other half. Extended Health Benefits (EHB) is totally paid for by your employer. With regard to Group Life contributions, you must pay .00097 of your gross salary (which amounts to \$1.58); the Provincial must pay .00563 of your gross salary (which amounts to approximately \$9.14). For Disability contributions, the figure indicated is .00466 of your gross salary. You must pay .85 of that amount; your employer must contribute 15% of the total amount indicated on the sheet enclosed. The employee's contribution to the UBC pension plan is based on 5% of your gross earnings. The employer contributes 10% of your gross earnings. Please note that CPP contributions are deducted in order to determine the actual amounts owed by the employee and the employer.

The above information is based on benefits owed for one month. Remember that the amounts indicated for you, Lid, are for two months.

In addition, we would appreciate it if you submit, to this office, the regular union dues minus the per capita tax owed (as per your suggestion) which is \$8.75 each month.

And, once again, a reminder: please forward more provincial membership card forms as soon as possible. Thank you.
