Two problems for your consideration and opinion.

First, the application from the LRB. I am uncertain whether OTEU 15 is applying for everyone working in the Thunderbird Winter Sports Centre. I understand from Marcel that the Centre is now operating as a separate entity. The technical employees and those working in the rink office are now members of CUPE. We have two people working in the building. They are Edna Johnson and Jeannie Smith, both UBC Physical Education employees. They work in the building during part of the yearonly, namely the summer, as part of the field sports camp. Our position will be the same as other applications involving our members, that these people are UBC employees and properly certified as members of our bargaining unit. Please make the necessary submission on our behalf and ask for me any additional information you require. If the application involves more than the ice arena, we have other members working in several of the gyms.

Second, I am enclosing a letter received Friday afternoon from Robert Grant. We have not told the University as yet that we are prepared to discuss their proposal on restructuring. One of several things can be happening.

- The University will withdraw their restructing proposal given the very low general increase we expect from the government,
- 2. The University has taken our statement that we will not negotiate the restructuring proposal seriously,
- They are just stalling for time and can afford to have a meeting(s) with us.
