Dear Sirs:-

The Assistant Manager, Outports Dept., of the North German Lloyd at New York, has requested me to give you certain particulars regarding recent customs tariff alterations in Germany.

By a decree published in the Reichsgesetzblatt (Official Gazette) of March 7th, a new tariff column (Upper Tariff) has been instituted. Another decree, applying certain items of this new tariff to Canadian products, has meanwhile been promulgated, to take effect as regards Canada as from April 1st. The tariff items concerned are ^{shown} contained in the enclosed list. The commodities mentioned in the list do not represent the complete tariff items, they are merely short designations for the items in question.

I have not so far been informed as to the rates applying with regard to these items. *I shall be glad to communicate with you later on when*
