I have your letter of the 8th instant, referring to Departmental letter of December 16th last, and asking to be advised where Customs Duty Stamps, as referred to in the previous letter, may be obtained by firms in Germany.

Although there is no office in Germany from which the above mentioned Stamps may be obtained, I may point out that they are available on application to the Secretary, High Commissioner for Canada, Canada House, Trafalgar Square, London, S.W.l, England.

As requested, I am enclosing two copies of Memo. Series D No. 49 TMR 2 (Revised), and you will note that the above address in England is set forth in the last part of paragraph 2 on page 1.
