Biographical History:

A. Alexis Alvey was born in Seattle, Washington. She attended McMaster University in Hamilton (1932-33). Following University, she was employed as a special technician in charge of photography at the University of Toronto's School of Medicine. Alvey also helped organize the business women's company of the Toronto Red Cross Transport Corps and commanded it for two years, and served as lecturer to the entire Transport Corps for Military Law, Map Reading, and Military and Naval insignia.

In 1942, the Women's Royal Canadian Naval Service (W.R.C.N.S., "Wrens") selected Alvey for its first class for training in Ottawa. Having passed a selection board to become one of the first commissioned officers, Dorothy Isherwood, W.R.C.N.S., appointed Alvey acting Chief Petty Officer Master-at-Arms. Her other assignments included duty as Deputy Unit Officer H.M.C.S. Bytown (Ottawa), duty with the Commanding Officer Pacific Coast H.M.C.S. Burrard (Vancouver), assignment as Unit Officer, Lieutenant H.M.C.S. Bytown, and Unit Officer to H.M.C.S. Stadacona (Halifax). Following her career with the W.R.C.N.S., Alvey rejoined University of Toronto in 1945. Eventually, Alvey returned to Seattle to work for the University of Washington Libraries as an acquisitions technician, but retired in 1969. Alvey died on June 5, 1996.

Throughout her life, Alvey took special care to collect and preserve memorabilia related to the activities of the W.R.C.N.S. She regularly accepted donations from former W.R.C.N.S. to aid her documentary activities.

Scope and Content:

The fonds consists of scrapbooks, correspondence, logs, photographs and subject files relating to Alvey's career, and the activities of the Women's Royal Canadian Naval Service. The fonds also includes the scrapbooks of former W.R.C.N.S., Grace Brodie and Dorothy Isherwood. The fonds divides into seven series: Subject Files - 1940-1985, Scrapbooks - 1942-1977, Canadian Navy, Logs - 1943-1944, Photographs and posters - [ca.1940?]-1958, Women's Royal Canadian Naval Service - 1942-1984, WRCNS Reunions - 1950-1985.

Series Description:**Series 1: Subject Files. - 1940-1995**

Series consists of correspondence, clippings, postcards, photographs, newsletters, and other printed material on a variety of subjects primarily related to the W.R.C.N.S. These subjects include administration, women and women's services, files on persons, ships, uniforms, reports, the Royal Canadian Navy, publishers, poems, prayers, various cities in Canada, and music.

Series 2: Scrapbooks. – 1942-1977.

Series consists of scrapbooks created by W.R.C.N.S. troops. The scrapbooks include photographs and clippings documenting the activities of the W.R.C.N.S.

Series 3: Canadian Navy.

Grace Brodie. – 1942-1945.

Series consists of photographs and clippings in scrapbooks which relate to Brodie's duties at various stations.

Series 4: Logs. - 1943-1944.

Series consists of two appointment books listing daily activities.

Series 5: Photographs and posters. - [ca.1940?]-1958.

Series consists of an album, and loose photographs depicting various ships, a recruiting display, W.R.C.N.S in the first Vancouver unit, W.R.C.N.S. reunions in Toronto and Vancouver, the H.M.C.S. Chippewa unit, and a W.R.C.N.S Anniversary banquet. Series also contains a W.R.C.N.S' poster.

Series 6: Women's Royal Canadian Naval Service. - 1942-1995

Series consists of newsletters, histories, regulations, clippings, and material from the Vancouver W.R.C.N.S. Association such as membership lists and correspondence.
