THE CONSTITUTION STIPULATES THAT ANY PROTEST ALLEGING AN UNFAIR BALLOT, OR 'OTHER IRREGULARITY', MUST BE FILED WITHIN FOURTEEN (14) DAYS OF THE PUBLICATION OF THE BALLOT RESULTS. THE PROTEST MUST BE FILED IN WRITING, AND MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE PROVINCIAL OFFICE, BY WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 1981. ANY PROTESTS MUST BE ADDRESSED TO: THE PROVINCIAL EXECUTIVE, AUCE PROVINCIAL, #901-207 W.Hastings St., Vancouver. IF THERE IS A PROTEST, THE PROVINCIAL EXECUTIVE WILL CONSIDER IT ON FRIDAY EVENING, SEPTEMBER 25, 1981, @ THE AUCE PROVINCIAL OFFICE. IF THE PROTEST IS UPHeld, THEN ANOTHER BALLOT MUST BE CONDUCTED. OTHERWISE THE NEW EXECUTIVE TAKES OFFICE ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 1981. (See Section 9, Voting Procedures, of the Constitution).
