IF THERE IS A PROTEST, THE PROVINCIAL EXECUTIVE WILL CONSIDER IT ON FRIDAY EVENING, SEPTEMBER 25, 1981, @ THE AUCE PROVINCIAL OFFICE. IF THE PROTEST IS UPHELD, THEN ANOTHER BALLOT MUST BE CONDUCTED.
