# MEMORANDUM

## TARIFF CHANGE BY ORDER IN COUNCIL

By Order in Council (P.C. 2757), dated the 4th November, 1938, passed under authority of Section 284, paragraph (k) of the Customs Act, the following regulation is made and established:

### R E G U L A T I O N

The following goods, imported to be used as materials in Canadian manufactures, are hereby transferred to the list of goods which may be imported into Canada free of duty:

"Tungsten carbide, encased in metal tubes, for use in Canadian manufactures

British Preferential Tariff.....	Free
Intermediate Tariff.....	Free
General Tariff.....	Free"

(to be designated as Tariff item 829).

The Order in Council referred to is effective on and after the 12th November, 1938, the date of publication in the "Canada Gazette".
