Subject: Tariff status of Paper Fasteners.

Gentlemen:-

With further reference to your letter of January 26th last, you are advised that the paper fasteners, per sample submitted, made of iron or steel, not electro-plated, are rated for duty under tariff item 446a at 25% ad valorem, under the Canada-United States Trade Agreement, to the benefits of which Germany is entitled as a most favoured nation.

The paper fasteners, per sample submitted, made of tin-plate, not electro-plated, are rated for duty under tariff item 432d at $27\frac{1}{2}\%$ ad valorem, Intermediate Tariff.

In addition to the duty there is payable a special excise tax of 3% and the consumption or sales tax of 8%, both payable on the duty paid value.
